petitioner, a Cooperative Society, does not receive any governmental

assistance and nor does the government hold any shares, the Right to

Information Act, 2005, does not apply to the petitioner.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and express my

inability to issue the writ as prayed in view of the judgment of this

Court in Hindu Urban Co-operative Bank Limited V/s State

Information Commission and others, 2011(2), RCR (Civil) 915,

wherein after considering the provisions of the Act and judgments of

the various High Courts, it has been clearly held that the provisions of

the Act apply to a Co-operative Society. I find no reason whether in

fact or in law to adopt a different view.

In this view of the matter, the writ petition is dismissed.
